CONDITIONS

1. All entries are free and open to members of the Australian Orchid Council and Orchid Society of NSW Inc., and its affiliated Societies, Interstate Orchid Societies, Overseas Orchid Societies and individuals.
2. Entries are received on the basis that the Sponsor shall not be responsible for any loss, destruction or damage to such exhibits, and the exhibitor shall have no claim whatsoever against the sponsor or any of the Societies involved.
3. Plants competing for prizes shall have been owned by, and in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding six months.
4. All plants exhibited must be healthy and free of pests and diseases. The Show Marshal's decision in this matter shall be final.
5. The Show Marshal reserved the right to reject, remove or rearrange any exhibit. Extra classes may be created at the discretion of the Show Marshal.
6. All plants entered should be correctly and clearly labelled with the name of the plant. Labels Plants that are labeled will be judged , other plants may be judged at the judges discretion..
7. Judging shall be by a panel of Judges nominated by or approved by the Australian Orchid Council, and judging shall be in accordance with the standards and By-laws laid down by the Australian Orchid Council. The Judges decision is final. No correspondence or debate will be entered into.
8. An exhibitor shall not remove plants, an exhibit or part thereof before the end of the show, without the permission of the Show Marshal.
9. No flower or fruit, other than Orchids and Anthuriums may be used in any display.
10. Exhibitors may use ferns/foilage to embellish exhibits. Such plants will not be taken into consideration in judging, except for decorative effect in display classes.
11. Entries in Seedling classes MUST be nominated on the form provided. Nomination forms must be in the hands of the Show Marshal no later than 7pm on Wednesday 18th July, 2018.
12. A seedling shall mean the complete plant grown from seed and flowering for the first time. It shall retain its seedling status throughout the flowering season in which it first flowered.
13. Species should be nominated on the form provided to assist the Judges locating the plants or cut spikes. Judges may judge species that have missed nomination. Nomination forms must be in the hands of the Show Marshal no later than 7pm on Wednesday 18th July, 2018.
14. Cut racemes are only eligible for Cut Flower Champions.
15. The Orchid Society of NSW reserves the right to photograph, for its own purposes, any exhibit in the Show.
16. Unless otherwise specified, all Classes are for Hybrids only.
17. The judging panel will decide if a plant benched in a species class is a species. No correspondence will be entered into where the panel is not satisfied a plant is a species.
18. Eligibility for nomination for the Hermon Slade Award. Australasian Orchid as defined by the Australasian Native Orchid Society.
19. Dyed or artificially coloured flowers are not permitted in exhibition or plant sales areas.
20. The classes for vandaceous have been changed to Aeridinae this is a more positive heading, some schedules use Vandaeae however Vandaeae includes Polistachyinae which is not monopodial. It excludes Angraecinae from these classes.
